CERTIFICATION

The undersigned/above named Participant certifies his/her understanding and agreement regarding all of the following:

1. Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure (FRBP) 9011 requires that every pleading, motion, and other paper (except lists, schedules, statements or amendments thereto) filed with the Court be signed by at least one attorney of record or, if the party is not represented by an attorney, by the party. Any login issued to a Participant by the Court identifies that Participant to the Court each time [s]he logs on to the ECF system. The Participant shall be solely responsible to the Court regarding each record entered into the ECF system using the Participant's login. The use of a Participant's login constitutes the signature of the Participant for purposes of FRBP 9011 and any other authority relating to signatures on any document or pleading filed electronically using a Participant's login. Therefore, a Participant must protect and secure any court-issued login and its corresponding password (e.g., see General Order (G.O.) #03-3). If the Participant has any reason to suspect his/her password relating to a court-issued login has been compromised, the Participant will immediately change the password.
2. The originals of all electronically filed pleadings, affidavits, and other documents that require verification under FRBP 1008, or an unsworn declaration (e.g., per 28 U.S.C. §1746), will be maintained by the Participant, or the firm representing the party on whose behalf the document was filed, for ten years.
3. Upon receipt of notification from the Court that [s]he has been approved for use of the ECF system as a Participant with a fully activated login Participant will: (a) electronically file all documents using the ECF system, except when otherwise permitted by a Court Order or Administrative Procedure; (b) NOT ALTER any text or the format of any Local Bankruptcy Form ("LBF"); AND (c) in lieu of conventional service, accept electronic service of pleadings, orders and other documents in accordance with the provisions of all Rules, and Court Orders and Administrative Procedures.
4. Participant will comply with all Local Rules; Court Orders; and any Administrative Procedures, Style Guides, Event Charts, User Manuals, etc. relating to the ECF system.
