**Failure to Object or Serve Proper Notice of Hearing.** If neither the debtor nor the codebtor files both a timely objection and the proper notice of hearing, then the stay protecting the codebtor may expire pursuant to § 1201(d), or the court may sign an order, submitted by the moving party, without further notice.
