GENERAL ORDER NO. 22-1

On April 24, 2020, the court issued General Order No. 20-4 adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020 in accordance with the signing into law of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (the “CARES Act”). Provisions in the CARES Act that implicate Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020 have now expired.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that General Order No. 20-4 is rescinded and the pre-CARES Act Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020 adopted via General Order No. 20-1 remains in effect until further order of the court or adoption of the rule on a national basis.
