1007-1	Replaces a superfluous cross-reference with a reference and link to Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I.
1017-1	Cross-reference added in conjunction with revisions to LBR 9013-1(b)(2) exempting motions to convert.
1017-2	Cross-reference added in conjunction with revisions to LBR 9013-1(b)(2) exempting motions to dismiss.
2002-1	Language added to clarify interplay between the local rule and national rules' notice and objection periods, along with a new procedure re: shortened notice periods.
2003-1	Clarification to reflect 2018 procedural changes re: converted cases, and a revised cross-reference re: a 2017 procedural change for obtaining audio of a 341(a) meeting.
2016-1	Cross-reference revised in conjunction with revisions to LBR 3001-1.
3001-1	Revisions mainly removed subsections re: transfers of claims, as the national rules adequately cover this subject.
3007-1	Changed to note the added/revised LBFs re: the new claims objection process.
3011-1	Customized and replaced the LBF handling unclaimed funds, along with governing procedures reflecting a national consensus.
3019-1	Minor revision simplifying redline/strikeout requirements for a plan and disclosure statement.
5005-4	Added clarity and removed reference to special notice requests, which the court discontinued the practice of accepting earlier this year.
7001-1	Cross-reference revised in conjunction with revisions to LBR 9019-1.
9011-3	Cross-reference revised in conjunction with revisions to LBR 9019-1.
9013-1	Revisions to clarify when the notice of motion rule applies; the applicability of the new rule re: shortened notice periods; and a new cross-reference to LBR 2002-1(d)(1).
9018-1	Revisions re: documents filed under seal or submitted unfiled for review in chambers.
9019-1	Rules 9019-1 & 9019-2 have been revised and collapsed into the new 9019-1, covering both current practices for settlement & compromise, along with updated practices for mediation.
9019-2	Removed; see above.
9021-1	Clarification added to explain situations in which it is appropriate to lodge orders concurrently with motions or applications.
